### Welcome to Walkley Festival 2024

The Festival is hosted by Walkley Community Forum and supported by Sheffield City Council. This year's theme is 'Makers & Creators' because there's such an abundance of creative talent in Walkley. We're celebrating this, along with all the other things that make our neighbourhood such a friendly, vibrant place to live and visit.

We've condensed the Festival to one week (two weekends) this year. But, that doesn't mean there isn't still a fantastic, jampacked line-up of events and ALL the Festival Favourites! Kicking things off on *Friday 28th June*, the **Pub Crawl** is back by popular demand (along with other events - see Calendar

The main Festival really takes off with a bang on the **South** Road Launch Day on Saturday 29th. The Library will be hosting the Children's Library Garden (see Launch Day page). You'll be treated to a fabulous programme of live music throughout the day - on The Green (opposite Asda), at St. Mary's and in the Medical Centre 'Food Court'. A fantastic selection of Food & Drink will be available in the Medical Centre Food Court on Greenhow Street and marvellous Makers Markets will be held in Walkley Community Centre AND St. Mary's Church & Hall. All this and a fabulous 'Find Alfredo' (the new Festival Mascot) Treasure Hunt!

'Super Sunday' (on 30th June) is a great opportunity to get out and about to explore. There'll be a multitude of things to see and do throughout the day, across the whole of Walkley! Including Open Gardens, with events on some of the Green Spaces, plus a Yard Sale Trail. It's also the start of the Walkley Art Show in St Mary's Community Hall and some of the local artists will be opening their studios.

Events continue throughout the week and bringing the main Festival to a close is the fabulous Festival Finale in Ruskin Park on Saturday 6th July. You'll be treated to two stages of Live Music, a great selection of Market & Charity / Community Stalls, a fabulous array of Food & Drinks, a Climbing Wall, Bouncy Castle, Face Painting and lots more! There really is something for everyone!

But the fun doesn't stop here! There are even more events on Sunday 7th July (see Calendar) and a FREE Taster Session with the wonderful Walkley Community Choir on Tuesday 9th July at 18:30 in St Mary's Hall (everyone is welcome primary school age upwards).




